Mission & Overview

The mission of the Summer Internship Program is to continue to positively impact the lives of our local youth by providing structured educational programs that build character, instill life-enhancing values and promote healthy choices through the game of golf all while providing opportunities to expand on leadership roles, planning and execution of tasks, responsibility, and a first hand look into a real world job experience.

This program provides an opportunity to a deserving TFTGC participant to work with outreach and Core Golf & Life Skills participants teaching basic life and golf skills. Programs will be held at Patriots Point Links from June 7th through August 22st two (2) to six (6) days per week with occasional outreach opportunities elsewhere in the Greater Charleston area.
